INTENTION TO APPLY FOR YEAR 7 ENTRY TO A SELECTIVE HIGH SCHOOL IN 2019

Selective high schools cater for high achieving academically gifted students who may otherwise be without sufficient classmates at their own academic and social level. These schools help gifted and talented students to learn by grouping them with other gifted and students. teaching talented them in specialised ways and providing educational materials at the appropriate level.

Applications for selective high school placement are considered mainly on the basis of the Selective High School Placement Test results and school assessment scores. The Selective High School Placement Test will be held on Thursday 15 March 2018.

If you would like to have your child considered for Year 7 selective high school entry in 2019, you need to apply soon. You will need to apply on the internet using a valid email address (not the student's email address).

Detailed instructions on how to apply online will be available from 10 October 2017 in a printed application information booklet and at <u>https://education.</u> nsw.gov.au/public-schools/selective-highschools-and-opportunity-classes/year-7.

The application website opens at <u>https://education.nsw.gov.au/selective-high-schools-and-opportunity-classes/year-7</u> on 10 October 2017 and closes on 13 November 2017. You must apply before the closing date.

There are no paper application forms available. If you do not have internet access, you could apply at a public library or contact the school office for assistance. If you have a disability that prevents you from using a computer, you can contact the Unit or school office for assistance after 10 October 2017. You must submit only ONE application for each student.

Please return your note as soon as possible to indicate your intention to apply.




